take action and change their behaviors.




## **Program Overview**

## **Behavior Changing Outcomes**

As a result of the program...

- 100% Intend to use reusable shopping bags
- 100% Intend to use reusable water bottles
- 57% Intend to compost or vermicompost
- 88% Intend to incorporate native plants in their landscapes
- 88% Intend to install low flow shower heads or faucet aerators
- 100% Intend to reduce chemical fertilizers and use organic alternatives
- 100% Intend to keep thermostat set at recommended temperatures
- 100% Intend to change from incandescent to CFL or LED bulbs
- 100% Intend to purchase or make their own green cleaners
- 100% Intend to protect amphibians, reptiles and "good pests" in the garden
